

NEW BESPOKE CARBON FIBRE PANEL PRODUCER ENTERS MARINE SECTOR

Carbon Weezel, the fast-growing, Southampton-based bespoke carbon fibre panel manufacturer, has announced its launch into the marine market.

For the past eight years the company has been servicing the automotive industry, although during this time it has created some interesting and unique custom-manufactured carbon fibre interior panels for the boat sector as well.

Carbon Weezel produced its first marine dash board specifically for a Sealine C39. The unit was formed of eight separate panels all moulded and fitted in-house. Within twenty-four hours of being fitted to the craft, the dash was noticed by the Editor of Motor Boat & Yachting magazine and was immediately awarded 'MBY product of the month' status.



Since then, the company has produced dash panels for Sunseeker, Portofino and Camarque vessels.

To produce its various panels and units, the company employs high grade, UV stable, marine specification resin. All components are finished to the highest quality and in a durable gloss that, unlike conventional marine materials, are not adversely affected by the harsh marine environment. As such, they can be expected to last for many years.

"Many boat owners are rightly proud of their boats or yachts and are keen to 'personalise' them", says Nick Worsell, Managing Director of Carbon Weezel. "Since Carbon Weezel custom-make panels and other units, many as one-offs, I am confident that the marine market will present us with many interesting challenges over the coming months.
